New bath towels, full size shampoo, new twin bed sheets, new pillows, toilet paper, soap, dish soap, cleaning supplies, deodorant, laundry detergent, toothpaste, toothbrushes, notebook paper, containers of coffee grounds (yes coffee we love our men and want to give them a warm cup of coffee each morning☺) and stamps

We estimate the expense for each man in the program runs close to \$10,000 however, we only ask our men to pay \$4500 we do not turn men away based on need; we believe in providing hope and help to every man.

\$4500 will cover the expense of one man in the ten-month program

\$2250 will cover the expense of one man for the first half of the program

\$1500 will provide meals for several men for one month

\$1000 will provide daily supplies (toiletries, cleaning supplies, etc.) for our men for one month

\$500 will provide classroom materials and curriculum, stamps, Bibles, books for our men

\$250 will provide start up packs for men coming into the program: clothes, shoes, socks, etc.
